- ▶ Request more information on site

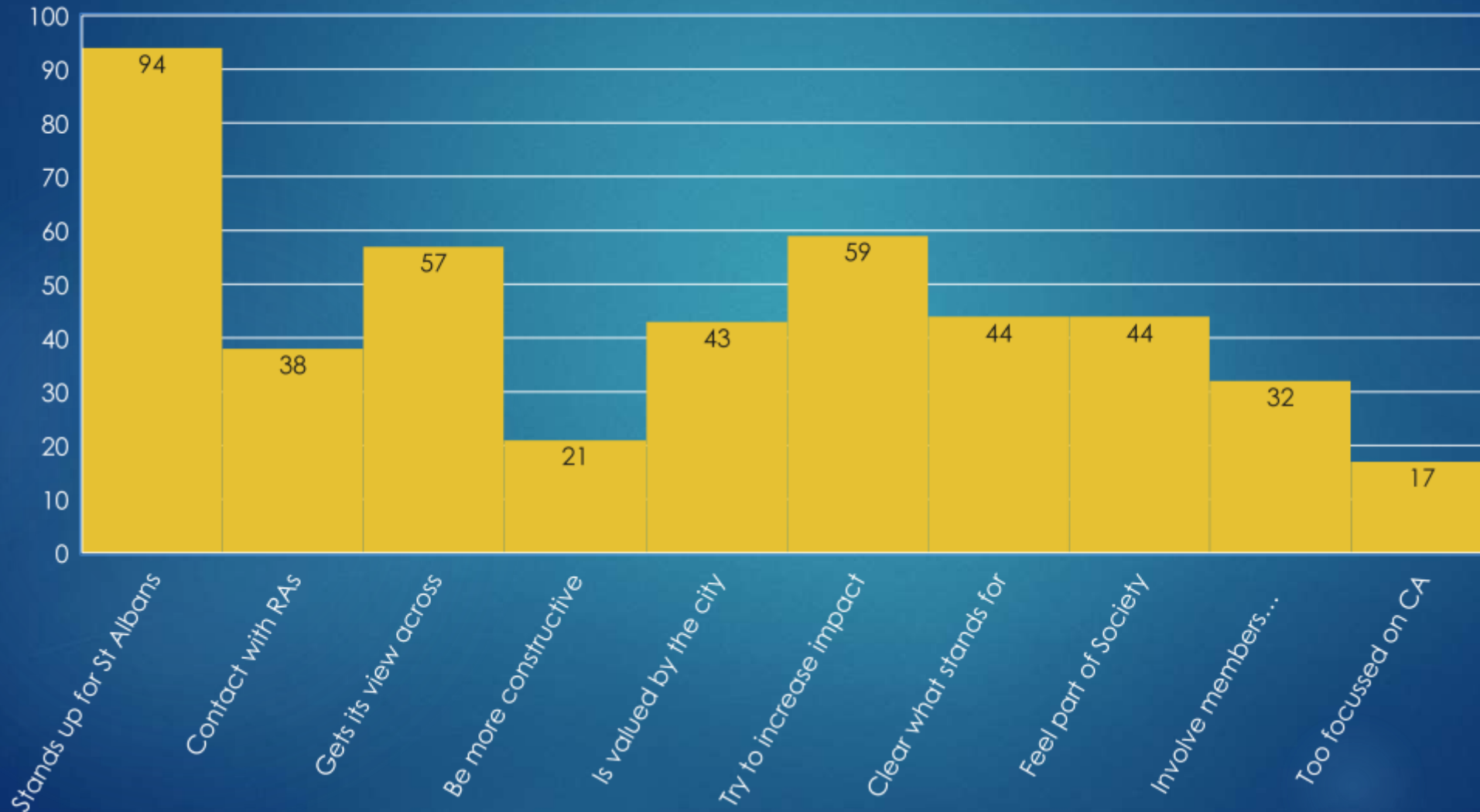

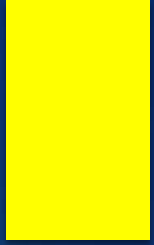

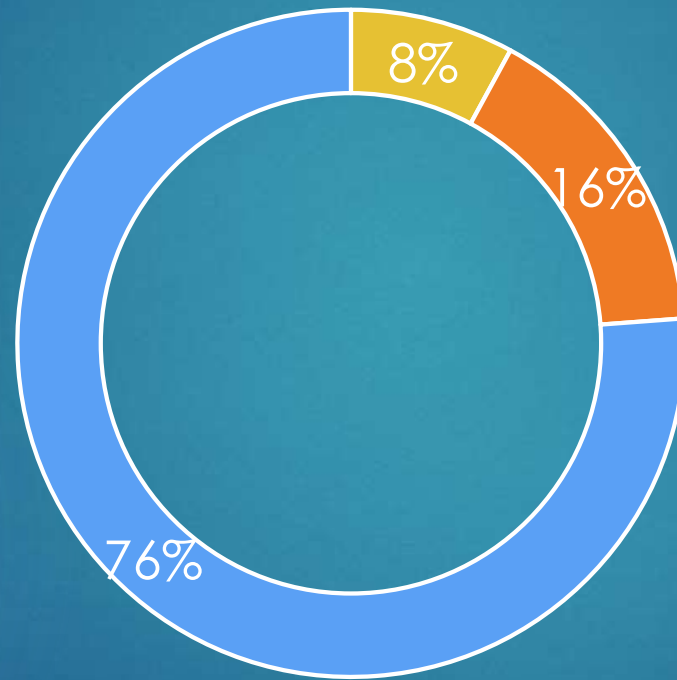
- ▶ 41% attended a talk in last year, 26% never attended

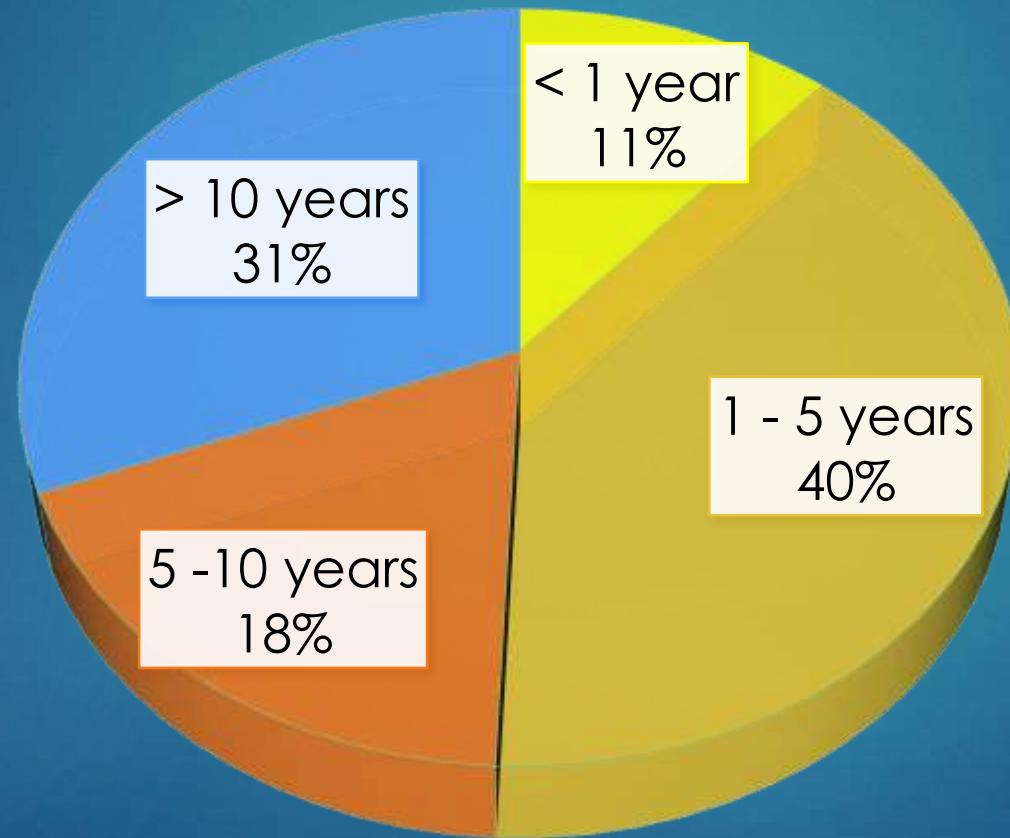
Age group
